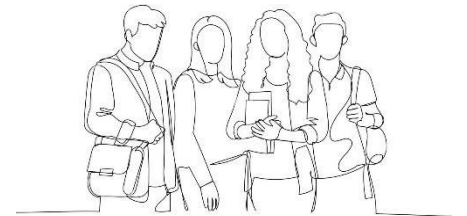

# Who can apply?

With the Erasmus+ program, UPO offers the opportunity to study abroad at one of the partner universities with which it has a bilateral agreement to all regularly enrolled students.

## Particular cases:

Infermieristic students cannot apply to the Call. We remind that you can take a study period abroad with the Erasmus+ for Traineeship Call or with the Free Mover project.



# Mobility duration

Erasmus+ for Study mobility period lasts at least 3 months and cannot exceed 12 months.

For each study cycle (Bachelors/Master) you can take a maximum of 12 months of international mobility in the frame of Erasmus+ Call; for the single cycle courses the maximum is of 24 months.



# What you can do

## What I can Do ✓

- Takes courses and exams in the partner University (a curricula activity at least);
- Research for the thesis;
- A study period combined with a Traineeship period in the same University.

**NB:** all the activities included in your OLA (Online Learning Agreement) and successfully passed will be recognized by UPO at the end of your mobility.

## What I cannot Do ⊘

- Take exams in UPO;
- Get a degree in UPO.

...and take other curricular activities (for example: laboratories...) because your career will be suspended during your international mobility..

# How can I chose the destination?

You need to:

- check the ISCED codes (didactic areas);
- check the study cycle for which the agreement is available [Bachelor (BA)/ Master (MA)];
- check the linguistic knowledge required (also by the website of each University you're interested in);
- check the courses catalogue of the Universities you're interested in.

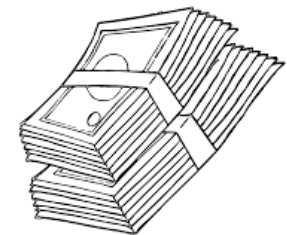
# Scholarship

According to your 2023/2024 ISEE – we calculate the scholarship grant for your international mobility.

The scholarship will be split: 70% within one month from your leaving and the last part after three months from your return (...but you have sent to us all the required documents before).

The scholarship includes multiple voices:

- European funds;
- Fondo Giovani MUR;
- University funds.

€50,00 for all the travel within the 4.000 km.

# European grant for students with special needs

**Funds by:** European Commission.

**WHO:** Students with special physical and health conditions.

**HOW:** Write an email to [domanda.erasmus@uniupo.it](mailto:domanda.erasmus@uniupo.it) and the Staff will give you all the information, according to the Erasmus+ INDIRE Agency requirement.

**HOW MUCH:** The grant is defined ad personam.

## Refund and Waiver

### Refund

- PARTIAL – If the period of mobility completed is less than that financed by the first instalment of payment (70%), a refund of the sum unduly received will be requested.
- TOTAL - In case of return before 3 months or failure to obtain some curricular credits, will be required to refund all the contribution paid (to which is added the penalty).

**NB:** career will remain blocked until the payment of the debt.

### Waiver

- In case of the Erasmus mobility project being abandoned, the student/student will be required to/or payment of a penalty of 100,00 €.

For proven and serious reasons, you may submit application for exemption from payment of the penalty.

You can apply through your Portale Studente. You have to open the lateral list and click on the last “Mobilità internazionale” voice. Here, you can find the application procedure.

When you apply, remember to flag the voice “Mobilità pregresse”; even if you never done an Erasmus+ before, it’s needed for the system to know this information: in this case you have to fill in the box with the 0 (zero). You also have to indicate your language level and it must be at least the when required by the partner University you chose.



# INSURANCE

Extension of the University's insurance coverage for civil liability and accidents during the course of study activities abroad, internship, thesis research.

The health coverage is guaranteed by the possession of the TEAM CARD for first aid.

Any other type of insurance is paid by the student and must be taken out independently.
