RESEARCH ACTIVITIES	The planned research activities fit within the lines of the relevant field and relate to the Age-It program of Spoke 10.  The overall theme is the exploration of the social determinants of aging patterns, defining the preferences and needs of older people and their fulfillment through the composition of professional and informal services in the provision of care to older and frail people. It is proposed to analyze heterogeneity in the provision of care in different local settings and through multiprofessional support networks, as well as to assess individual ability to access and activate support networks.  The research aims to assess new welfare policies in local contexts provided with a diverse composition of supply and utilization lattices in the neighborhood care system. Particular attention will be paid to local systems of care, formal and informal, in an aging society with shrinking and verticalization.  The research should evaluate the effects of new policies to support aging and produce suggestions for policy in geographic areas that are heterogeneous in population and services.
