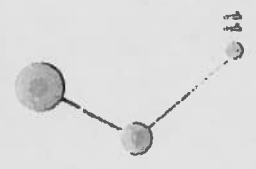

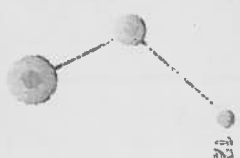

INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE PROGRAMMES

During the academic year 2016/17 students can also opt for a divided meal: they can ask for single portions, without the full or reduced meal limits, paying different prices according to the chosen dishes.
This service is available in Edisu canteens.
Single prices are available on the Edisu website, Food Services section.

Students involved in International exchange or Agon programmes will be assigned to the first price bracket.

Students possessor of magnetic strip card can access to Edisu University Canteens upon the submission to the Edisu office of a certification, issued by the host university, attesting the period of stay (or the date of arrival and the date of departure), the Department and the attended course.

Students who don't possess a magnetic strip card have to go to Edisu's offices in order to receive a Smart Card which allow them to access to Edisu canteens or substitute canteens' services with Edisu with a discounted price. In order to receive a Smart Card, the students must submit to the Edisu office a certification, issued by the host university, attesting the period of stay (or the date of arrival and the date of departure), the Department and the attended course.

If the students have to extend their stay, they have to provide a further certificate, issued by the host university, which attests the details of the extension: otherwise, the card will be disabled.

INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE PROGRAMMES

There are 8 EDISU university canteens in Piedmont: 5 in Turin, 1 in Alessandria and 2 in Grugliasco.
The canteens provide menu choices weekly varying and local specialties featuring.
Given free meals are available in our **Canteens**, **Canteen**, **Lungotevere**, **Principe Amedeo** canteens.
